HOW TO FILE A DISTRICT 1 GAME PROTEST

ALL PROTESTS MUST BE POST MARKED WITHIN 48 HOURS OF GAME DAY.

The Protest Record -- accompanied by the proper filing fee of \$50.00 by means of a money order or cashier's check -- must contain the following items:

Section One: At the game

1. The protesting coach shall advise the opposing coach and the referee of the decision to protest at the game site within fifteen (15) minutes after the end of the game.
2. The Referee must note the team's intent to protest on both team's game sheets and submit their written game reports to the District 1 office within 48 hours of game day.

Section Two: Protest Summary Sheet

1. Include the following items on a separate printed summary sheet:
2. Date of Game
3. Date of Incident/Hearing
4. Location
5. The nature and specifics of the protest or appeal complaint
6. Listing of the exact rules or procedures that have been violated, including rule and subsection number
7. A statement of the desired resolution

Section Three: Protest Support Documents

The applicable support documents:

1. All documents, exhibits and other evidence in the case, including photocopies of the individual rules or procedures that are the basis for the protest NOTE: *Please do not include the District 1 Rules or WSYSA Handbook in its entirety; only sections that are listed above.*
2. Original documents of the protest, along with all supporting documents and filing fee (see above), shall be forwarded by Certified or Registered US Mail - Return Receipt Requested to:
